Poll Clerks

Poll Clerks must be willing to work from 6:15am until 10.30pm on polling day and must attend a training session prior to the election.

You could be placed at a polling station anywhere within the Dover district area so must be prepared to travel.

The role includes checking ID against an elector and comparing it to their entry on the Register of Electors, issuing ballot papers, completing paperwork accurately and assisting voters who may need help to vote.

Pay is in the region of £250, including training.

Count Assistants

We will need Count Assistants to help count the votes that have been cast.

Parliamentary election counts are held overnight, but most other counts are held on the following day.

Pay for Count Assistants is in the region of £13.50 per hour for a daytime count and £20.00 per hour for an overnight count. The minimum amount you will be paid is for 4 hours work.
